- * Tag your harvest / Field dress your deer / Call in to the DNR or register your deer online.
- * Call friends and family for celebrating & help if necessary.
- * Prepare your deer for pictures by tucking in the tongue & cleaning up excessive blood. Check the background for things that could detract from your picture.
- * Make certain that the camera is at eye level with the trophy. Lay on the ground if necessary to take the picture.
- * Hang your deer or take it to a cooler or processor right away depending on the weather.
- * Contact a measurer from the Wisconsin Buck & Bear Club's website and see if your trophy qualifies for the Wisconsin Trophy Records Program.

WHITE-TAILED DEER

Archery/Crossbow: Typical -125", Non-Typical - 155"

Firearm/Collected: Typical -150", Non-Typical - 170"

BLACK BEAR

Archery/Crossbow: 18" **Firearm/Collected:** 19"

ELK

Archery/Crossbow/Firearm/Collected:

Typical - 240", Non-Typical - 280"

WOLF

Archery/Crossbow/Firearm/Collected/Trapping:

NO Minimum
